Nukkad Natak Rules & Regulations (Colleges)

1. **Team Composition:** 15-20 members including music or instrument handlers
2. **Teams Per College:** Maximum 2
3. **Registration:** Online
4. **Time Limit:** 10-15 minutes. Warning Bell will be rung after 10 minutes. Teams will be disqualified if they exceed the time limit.
5. Participating teams should choose socially relevant topics only.
6. No pre-recorded voices or music will be allowed.
7. The play must only be in Hindi/English.
8. Teams can use banners, posters, dholak, flute or any other musical instrument of their choice, but usage of mikes, lights or electrical instruments is not allowed.
9. The teams are expected to carry their own props.
10. Usage of abusive language is strictly prohibited, and vulgarity shall result in deduction of points and disqualification.
11. Performance should be confined within the Nukkad Area, as defined by the organizers.
12. Judges' collective decision will be final and binding.
13. No repeated performance is allowed.
14. Teams are advised not to repeat the idea. New concepts and stories with developed ideas are welcome.
15. Only Position Holders (**First, Second, and Third**) will get the prize money as per the decision of the judges.

- 1. Team Composition:** 10-15 members including music or instrument handlers
- 2. Teams Per School:** Maximum 2
- 3. Registration:** Online
- 4. Time Limit:** 07-10 Minutes. Warning Bell will be rung after 07 minutes. Teams will be disqualified if they exceed the time limit.
5. Participating teams should choose socially relevant topics only.
6. No pre-recorded voices or music is allowed.
7. The play must only be in Hindi/English.
8. Teams can use banners, posters, dholak, flute or any other musical instrument of their choice, but usage of mikes, lights or electrical instruments is not allowed.
9. The teams are expected to carry their own props.
